

City Winery Brisbane COVID-19 Safe Plan Plan

Due to COVID-19, and to ensure you can celebrate at City Winery in a safe environment, all staff City Winery have introduced the following covid-safe initiatives.

- All staff have undergone COVID19 Safe training
- All City Winery staff are directed to stay home if they feel ill. All staff are directed to remain home pending COVID19 testing results if they show any symptoms of the virus
- City Winery will operate within the maximum number of patrons while required by state legislation
- All City Winery non-essential face-to-face meeting will be postponed
- Signs and posters are placed throughout the venue to remind guests and staff of the COVID19 restrictions and guidelines
- Signs placed at entrances to venue to instruct patrons not to enter if they are unwell
- City Winery limit walk-in appointments through the use of online booking systems
- City Winery encourage the application of social distancing by marking 1.5m distances in waiting areas and queues
- City Winery will place restaurant tables 1.5m apart
- Provide contactless payment options where possible
- Single-use or laminated menus, which will be sanitized between uses
- City Winery will operate under a table service only system
- City Winery will maintain a contact list for tables seated in the venue
- City Winery provides handwashing and additional hand sanitizing stations throughout the venue for staff and guests

- City Winery will operate strict table clearing guidelines. Staff are required to wash or sanitize hands between setting and clearing each table.
- City Winery will sanitize frequently touched areas hourly, including eftpos, staff-area surfaces, door handles, sinks, bathrooms and shared equipment and tools
- Guests surfaces including tables and chairs will be cleaned or sanitized between guests
- Signed COVID-Safe Checklist available if requested by a relevant compliance/enforcement officer
